Discussion Guide

Getting Started

Have people in your group share some of their favorite hymns or Christian songs.

Why do you think more Christians don't seem to enter into SINGING to each other on Sundays?

How can we alleviate these obstacles?

Read Ephesians 5:18-19

Paul indicates that one evidence of being “filled” with the Spirit (under the control and influence of the Spirit) is singing to each other.

Why do you think that singing to each other is an important expression of being filled with the Spirit?

Read Psalm 59:16, 63:7

Give some examples of how singing to each other teaches us about theology and Christian living?

Read Psalm 100:1-2, 104:33

If the One-Anothers in Scripture are commands, then singing to each other is not an option for followers of Christ. *What suggestions would you give to someone who wants to fulfill this command, but they REALLY can't sing?*

Read Psalm 9:2

If we choose not to SING to each other, what do we miss out on?

How do you know when there is a song you shouldn't sing to each other?



SING TO EACH OTHER APPLICATIONS IDEAS

1. Listen only to Christian Music in your car for a week.
2. Play Christian music in your house.
3. If your work allows, listen to Christian music this week instead of talk radio.
4. Send someone a link to a Christian song that has impacted your life and walk with God.
5. Text or email someone words from a Christian song with an explanation of why this song encouraged you.
