Getting Started

Discuss common reasons why Christians don't Advance God's Kingdom more consistently.

Sermon Interaction

Read Romans 3:10-20

What's the bad news about people?

Read Romans 5:1, 6:23, 8:1, 10:13

What's the good news regarding these same people?

Read Colossians 4:6

This verse addresses the way we should Advance God's Kingdom.

Discuss specific examples of how conversation full of grace/seasoned with salt applies to Advancing and some ineffective ways to advance.

Read I Corinthians 9:20-22

Discuss how the following relationships can be purposely used for Advancing God's Kingdom and how life issues can be used as a platform for sharing our faith.

Family, Friends, Neighbors, Co-workers, Hobbies, School-related (sports, drama, musicals, etc.)

Read I Timothy 2:1-4
