#### **Read Romans 6:14**

Jesus the Passover Lamb provided the means for us to live under grace. *What does it mean to live under grace?*

#### **Read Romans 6:1-2**

*Some people abuse grace by sinning more, but how should the sacrifice of Christ as our Passover Lamb motivate us to obey and follow Him more consistently?*

#### **Read Hebrews 9:11-12**

Christ's sacrifice as the Passover Lamb eliminated the need for continuous sacrifices to maintain our relationship with God.

*How can we take advantage of the permanent, unbroken access we have to God?*

#### **Read Hebrews 9:15**

Christ's death as the Passover Lamb secured for us a glorious, future inheritance. *Do our lives reflect that we are living with an eternal perspective or are we living for just the here and now?*
